In *An Examination of Sir William Hamilton's Philosophy* Mill makes a close interpretation of Aristotle's *Nicomachean Ethics*.

2. Mill Aristotelian legacy.

In the *System of Logic* Mill develops many arguments that tacitly demonstrate a strong Aristotelian legacy:

- Both have practical reasoning as method;
- Both have the same ground, Mill's practice corresponds to Aristotle's *praxis* ;
- For both, happiness is the ultimate end;
- For both, the virtues are means for happiness.
